



- Willingness to get involved as actors/performers;
- Ready to use their body and voice;
- Desire to work on improving themselves;
- No other prerequisites necessary;
- No language requirements.

*Leaders must have a proper level of English



GENERAL RESPONSABILITIES OF PARTICIPANTS

- Respect others and ensure basic rights and freedoms to participants and facilitators that all people are entitled to regardless of nationality, sex, age, national or ethnic origin, race, religion, language, or other status
- Be able to respect timetable of the educational activities
- Respect time and content framework
- Behave responsibly
- Be able to attend 100% of the program
- Be able to actively attend the entire duration of the youth exchange

- Settle all the agreed obligations regarding travel costs
- Be willing to transfer knowledge to the members of his/her organization
- Take care of working space and materials
- Be responsible for personal and others safety
- The organizational team keeps the right to exclude participants from the exchange or reduce/cancel the reimbursement of the travel costs of the participant in case that participant does not respect the rules and responsibilities of the exchange

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU?

- Your motivation to enjoy the exchange and your best curiosity to meet other cultures!
- Your passport or ID card
- Your European Health Insurance Card https://ec.europa.eu/social/main.jsp?catId=559 and travel insurance.
- All your **travel tickets** for reimbursement (remember to keep the boarding pass -> "A boarding pass is a document provided by an airline during check-in, giving a passenger permission to board the airplane for a particular flight. As a minimum, it identifies the passenger, the flight number, and the date and scheduled time for departure.");
- Your own towels, a sleeping bag and a pillow case (we will provide pillows)
- All necessary for personal hygiene, like shampoo, toothpaste, soap, hair dryer, etc... and comfortable warm clothes, raincoats, umbrellas.
- Your own water bottle, so we can avoid the use of plastic as much as possible
- Medicines if you need them (anti-allergy pills, pain killers, aspirin etc.)





Parish house "Regina Pacis" in Castelvecchio of Valdagno (province of Vicenza)

In the house there are 4 big rooms that can host up to 12 participants each (2 rooms on each floor). There are 5 showers and 4 toilets on each floor (the 1st and the 2nd floor). On the ground floor there is a kitchen and a dining room.







HOW TO REACH CASTELVECCHIO


The Youth Exchange will take place in Castelvecchio which is 10 km from Valdagno and is situated 800 metres above the sea level in the mountain area between two valleys, the Agno and the Chiampo valleys.

Following you will find some useful tips on how to reach Valdagno.

Once in Valdagno, we will meet you at the bus station and will go to Castelvecchio by bus together (we will organise bus transfer to pick you up).

There are only 2 time options of bus transfer provided:
1. Departure from Valdagno bus station at 18.30
2. Departure from Valdagno bus station at 21.00
Make sure that you arrive to Valdagno on time to be able to take one of the buses.











HOW TO REACH VALDAGNO










Option 1

From **TREVISO** airport you have to take the bus to the train station **Treviso Centrale**. Here you can find more information: https://mobilitadimarca.it/p/linee-e-orari/treviso-airbus.

Then you will take a train from **Treviso Centrale to Vicenza** in every one hour.

Anyway you can check the site of the Italian railway station, there is an English version, so it will not be difficult for you.

Option 2

From **TREVISO** airport you can take the bus to the train station of **Venezia-Mestre**:

The ticket costs 12€ one way (return ticket 22€ with 10 days validity). You can buy it online, (they say that you have a discount but it is not true... it costs the same also in the automatic ticket machine), or on board Ryanair flights or in the automatic ticket machine/ticket office in the airport.

Then you will take a train from Venezia-Mestre to Vicenza

There are trains from Mestre to Vicenza very often, anyway you can check the site of the Italian railway station, there is an English version, so it will not be difficult for you. The site is:

Prices go from 8,30€ up to 19,50€... The regional trains are cheaper than Frecciabianca, and it takes about 30 minutes more.

Milano-Bergamo Orio Al Serio Airport "Il Caravaggio"

From Milano-BERGAMO (Orio al Serio airport) you have to take the bus "Orio shuttle" to Milano Centrale (railway station).

The bus leaves from Arrivals every half an hour and it takes about 50 minutes to arrive in the Milano Centrale train Station. The ticket costs 10€.

You can check the timetable and you can also buy it online at this website https://www.terravision.eu/italiano/#.

Then you will take a train from Milano to Vicenza.


There are trains from Milano to Vicenza every hour, anyway you can check the site of the Italian railway station, there is an English version, so it will not be difficult for you.

From Milano Malpensa Airport

From Malpensa airport you have to take the **Malpensa express**, the train goes to **Milano Centrale** (railway station) 20 times every day.

The ticket costs 13€ one way (return ticket 20€ with 30 days validity).

You can check the timetable and you can also buy it on line at this website http://www.malpensaexpress.it/en/choose "on-line ticket" from "Milano Aeroporto" to "Milano Centrale".

Then you will take a train from Milano to Vicenza.


There are trains from Milano to Vicenza every hour, anyway you can check the site of the Italian railway station, there is an English version, so it will not be difficult for you. The site is: https://www.trenitalia.com/en.html. Prices go from 17,55€ up to 28,00€.

From Milano Linate Airport



Milano Linate you have **2 options** to get to Milano Centrale.

You can take Linate **shuttle**: https://www.milano-aeroporti.it/linate-shuttle/index.html.

The ticket will cost you 7,00 euro.

Another option is to take a **metro** and go till **San Babila stop**, then you can **change** and take the **red line** or you can have a short walk enjoying the street view of Milan and arrive till Duomo, then you have to **take the yellow line** using the same ticket and arrive to Milano Centrale.

Once you have arrived at the railway station you have to take the **train** to Vicenza.

There are trains from Milano to Vicenza every hour, anyway you can check the site of the Italian railway station, there is an English version, so it will not be difficult for you.

From Bologna Airport

From Bologna airport you have to take **Marconi Express** that in 7 minutes will take you to **Bologna Centrale Station**. More information you can find here:

Once in Bologna you have to take a **train** to Vicenza.

There are trains from Bologna to Vicenza every hour, anyway you can check the site of the Italian railway station, there is an English version, so it will not be difficult for you. The site is: http://www.trenitalia.com

Prices go from 13,05€ up to 29,00€.

The regional trains are cheaper than Freccia trains, but sometimes you can find special offers also for Freccia tickets.

You can also check **Flixbus** for better options.



HOW TO REACH VALDAGNO

Once you arrive in Vicenza

Go to the Bus Station


Once you're in Vicenza's train station, you've to take a bus to Valdagno (line that goes to Recoaro). You have to walk out the station and go to the left and walk about 150m to reach the bus station. The bus leaves almost every hour, and takes about 1 hour and 15 minutes to arrive in Valdagno.

2 Buy ticket physically

You can buy the ticket at the ticket machine, ticket's office or in the tabaccheria inside (a small shop with a lot of things!). To ask for the ticket you can try to ask it in Italian saying "Vorrei un biglietto per Valdagno per favore", or just use English, they usually get it. The bus that you are going to take is Linea 1 to Valdagno/Recoaro Terme and will leave from box 5.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

All accommodation and food costs will be covered by the project. Travel costs will be reimbursed according to the distance band fixed by the European Commission. You will receive back your travel costs up to the amount stated by the European Commission according to the distance band (see the table below), by giving us all your tickets, boarding passes and bills related to the travel. The reimbursement will be paid ONLY by bank transfer after receiving all the tickets.

DISTANCE BAND	AMOUNT OF MONEY REIMBURSEMENT	GREEN TRAVEL*
Between 100 and 499 KM	180 €	210 €
Between 500 and 1999 KM	275 €	320 €
Between 2000 and 2999 KM	360 €	410 €
Between 3000 and 3999 KM	530 €	610 €

^{*}GREEN TRAVEL: travel that use low-emissions means of transport for the main part of the travel, such as bus, train or car-pooling (instead of plane) receive a bigger amount of reinbursement.
